WHEREAS, The Project Management Institute (PMI) is the world's leading not-for-profit membership association for the project management profession, with more than half a million members and credential holders in 185 countries; and

WHEREAS, The Honolulu Chapter was established in 1997 with 25 members and the chapter received their Chapter Charter certificate on June 5, 1998. Membership has grown to over 800+ members in 2020; and

WHEREAS, The Honolulu Chapter decided to conduct virtual seminars, which helped novice professionals be certified as project management professionals (PMP); and

WHEREAS, the mission of PMI is to promote the project management practice and profession through networking, sharing of project experiences, training, education, and certification in the State of Hawai'i; and

WHEREAS, the vision of PMI is to have a growing and engaged chapter recognized for excellence and delivering value to the project management community; and
